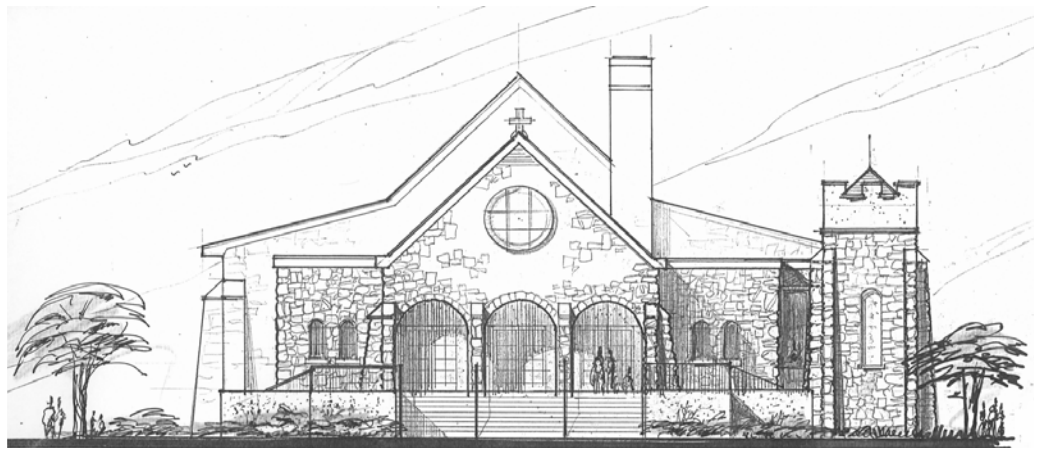

“Seek the Lord, all you humble of the earth, who have observed his law; seek justice, seek humility; perhaps you may be sheltered on the day of the Lord’s anger. But I will have as a remnant in your midst a people humble and lowly... How blest are the poor in spirit...”

How many people we know who spend their time pursuing what they do not have. Those without work read the want ads, write lengthy resumes and try to connect with someone to help them. Those with health issues look for a second opinion or find a specialist to address their needs. Young people look to guidance counselors at school to assist them in making a career choice.

But how few of us earnestly and eagerly seek the Lord. We presume God’s presence, but how rarely do we set out to strengthen our relationship with Him. Do I work for justice, am I humble and dependent before the Lord? The Lord asks me to ‘act justly, love tenderly and walk humbly before my God.’

Message from Fr. Bill

The Bishop, after much consultation, has made his decisions, made pursuant to recommendations of the Diocesan Planning Commission from the Planning Phase of the “Faith in Our Future Initiative.” In particular to Cohort 20: St. Denis, St. Peter, St. Martha, and Epiphany, the following has been decided: 1. Collaborative model for all four parishes in the Cohort. 2. Status of Epiphany to be reviewed no later than July 1, 2018.

Here is the working definition for “Collaborative Parish Model”: parishes within a cohort enter into a formal, collaborative relationship, working together on specific, agreed-upon shared areas of ministry, shared programs, shared staffing, shared resources; parishes remain distinct with their own pastor, pastoral and finance councils, finances, census and sacramental books; collaborative parishes work together whenever possible to do what a single parish cannot do effectively alone.

Throughout the Planning Phase, there has been great discussion and collaboration which has been directly due to the 16 parishioners, four from each parish, who were on the Cohort 20 Planning Committee. As we go forward, the four people who have represented our parish so well, will continue as the Implementation Committee. I thank Greg Boyle (Trustee), Ann Summers (Pres. Finance Council), Darcy Garuzzo (Pastoral Council Chairwoman), and Frank Garuzzo for all that they have done and will continue to do. Recall, it was from the Planning Phase that I began the Pastoral Council, and that the Cohort parishes decided on common dates for Pastoral and Finance council meetings, in order to facilitate joint meetings that will be needed for implementing the “Faith in Our Future Initiative” and meet the needs of the parishioners of our cohort.

Certainly, this is an important time and will call forth a great spirit of cooperation, collaboration, and, most importantly, communion. The Implementation Committee and I will continue to let you all know how things are progressing at each step of the way. Let us join together, in prayer, asking the patron saints of our cohort parishes and Our Blessed Mother, patroness of our diocese, to pray for our success- “May the favor of the Lord our God be ours. Prosper the work of our hands! Prosper the work of our hands!” (Psalm 90, v. 17)
