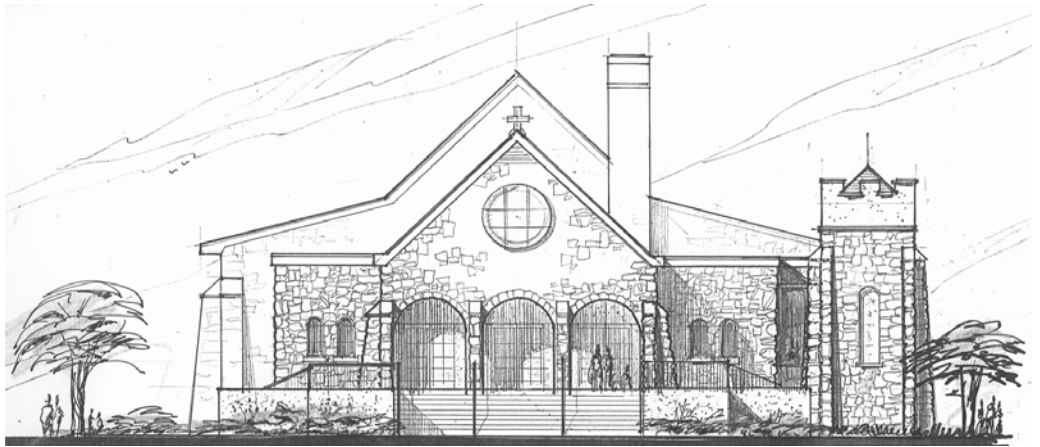
**EASTER SUNDAY OF
THE RESURRECTION
OF THE LORD**
April 16, 2017

“This man God raised on the third day and granted that he be visible, not to all the people but to us, the witnesses chosen by God in advance, who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead. He commissioned us to preach to the people, and testify that he is the one appointed by God to judge the living and the dead. To him all the prophets bear witness that everyone who believes in him will receive forgiveness of sins though his name.”

The resurrection accounts of Jesus’ appearances, following the empty tomb scene, are familiar and the source of hope and joy. The words of Peter in the sermon from the Acts of the Apostles, brings the meaning of His resurrection to us in 2017. Jesus’ redeeming sacrifice earns forgiveness and new life for us today.

Remember, this is the same Peter who shortly before denied knowing the Lord because of fear and intimidation. This sermon of Peter, and others he spoke, as did Paul, summon us to let Easter speak to us today. The Risen Lord offers us the gift of new life, won at Calvary, and generously given if we sincerely turn to Him.

May we let the grace of this day bring the richness of God’s grace to us all.

Message from Fr. Bill

Happy Easter! May God Bless you as we celebrate the Resurrection of our Lord, Jesus Christ and His Victory over sin and death. In the reality of this Easter Season we are given the grace to claim the victory of Christ!

How does God want you to share in Christ's victory this Easter? What grace do you need from God in order to be victorious? What does God want you to be confident about? A VIEW FROM THE PEW.... by Robert Butler, Pastoral Council Member

As soon as Father Bill formed the Pastoral Council for our parish, he asked the Pastoral Council to review the current school's parking lot and come up with a plan. The Pastoral Council discussed different options and presented a plan to Father Bill for his review. The plan has two elements, first is to re-seal the existing parking lot. Resealing the parking lot will provide two functions, first sealcoating the existing parking lot is much needed, and second the sealing will cover the old lines that are currently visible. The second part of the plan is to paint new arrows indicating a new traffic pattern and lines indicating parking spaces. Currently, there is no clear direction on traffic flow or parking spots. Resurfacing the parking lot, adding arrows, and parking spots will provide a clear traffic pattern. The Pastoral Council contacted multiple contractors to perform the work and presented the quotes to Father Bill. The plan was also presented to the Building Department of Manasquan for their review and comment. Since, we have received approval to proceed with the work from the Manasquan Building Department. Currently the work is being scheduled and will happen April 18-20.

PARKING LOT INFORMATION

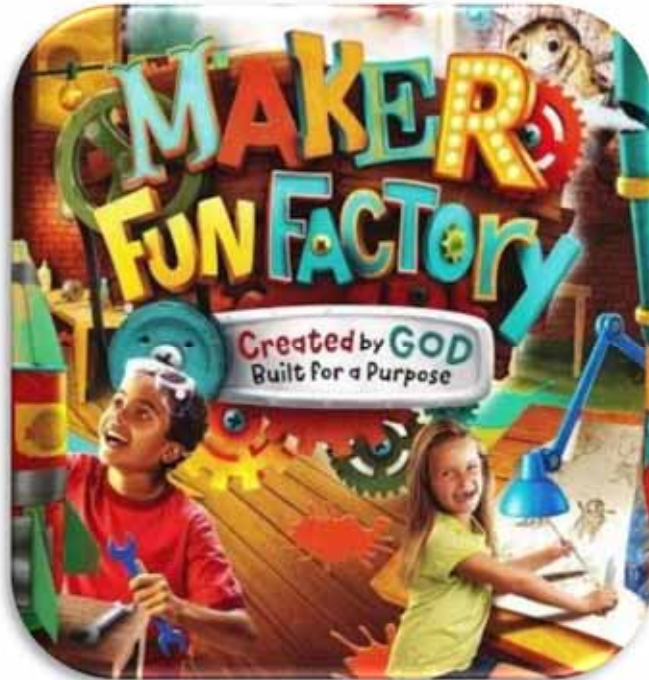
