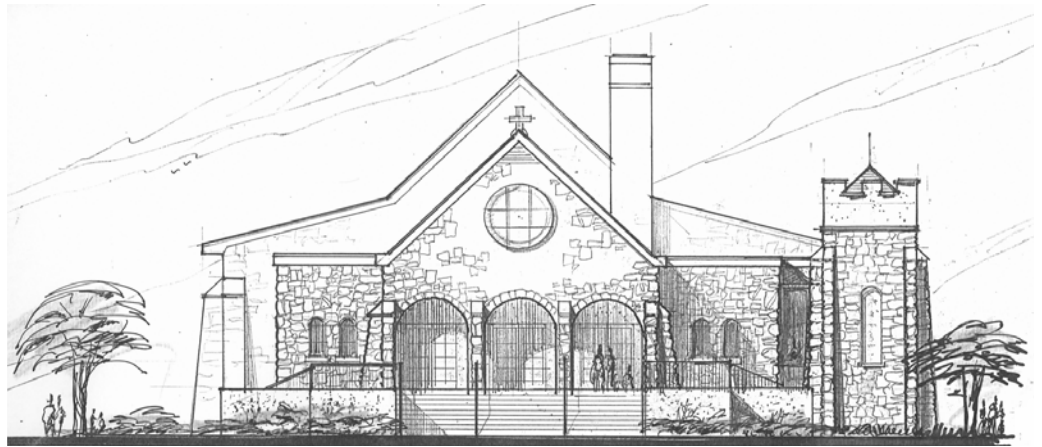

In today's Gospel hear Jesus tell us: "Whoever gives only a cup of cold water to one of these little ones to drink because the little one is a disciple—Amen, I say to you, he will surely not lose his reward." This week, know that you will bringing hope to the poor by your gift to the Society of St. Vincent de Paul. Thank you for your financial and food donations at the "Beach Reach".

On July 4<sup>th</sup> we celebrate the feast day of Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati. He was born in 1901 in Italy, and his mother taught him verses from the Gospels. Pier Giorgio was deeply moved by them, and developed an exceptional relationship with God. Indeed God reveals his love to "little ones." From the time he was twelve until his death at twenty-four Pier Giorgio received Holy Communion daily. At 17, he joined the Society of St. Vincent de Paul and committed himself to serving the poor. Pier Giorgio said: "Jesus visits me every morning in Holy Communion. I repay Him with my poor means, visiting the poor." When asked how he could stand the bad odors and dirt of the poor, he answered: "Don't forget that even if the house you visit is very dirty, there you may find Jesus." The last months of his life were filled with suffering as he contracted poliomyelitis and became paralyzed. When he died hundreds came to view his body and there was a line of unknown faces who loved this good and generous young man that always had a good smile for everyone. Pier Giorgio was beatified by Pope John Paul II on May 20, 1990.

**NATURAL FAMILY PLANNING AWARENESS WEEK IS COMING SOON!** So, what is Natural Family Planning (or NFP) anyway? The Church encourages married couples to learn about NFP methods because they represent *authentic* family planning that can be used both to *achieve* or *postpone* pregnancy. NFP makes use of periodic abstinence from sex based upon the observation of the woman's natural signs of fertility, in order to space births or to limit the number of children when there is a serious reason to do so. No drugs, devices, surgical procedures, or other artificial means are ever used to avoid pregnancy. This practice fosters in married couples an attitude of respect and wonder in their openness to human life, which is *always* sacred! It also fosters profound respect for one's spouse, which is necessary for authentic intimacy. *Be on the lookout for more information about Natural Family Planning in the bulletin each week leading up to Natural Family Planning Awareness Week, July 23-29.
