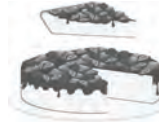

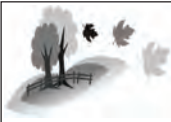
**THE SOCIETY OF

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER BILL

Today we celebrate Catechetical Sunday. As the U.S. Bishop's website states: Catechetical Sunday is a wonderful opportunity to reflect on the role that each person plays, by virtue of Baptism, in handing on the faith and being a witness to the Gospel." As we are in the years of the Eucharistic Revival, the theme is: "*This is my body given for you*" Those who the parish community has designated to serve as catechists are a great gift to the ministry of the parish, in which we live the words of our Lord through our worship at the Eucharistic celebration each Sunday and through our living the words giving of ourselves for God and neighbor, through works filled with Faith, Hope and Love. I ask you to join me in praying for our catechists and praying for our students in Religious Education and their families as we begin a new year of sharing the Faith.

The other week I attended a meeting at the Monmouth County Prosecutors Office with other religious officials and members of Law Enforcement as they discussed several items of importance. One of which is the upcoming "Faith and Blue" initiative. "National Faith and Blue Weekend" is an event which gives an opportunity for people of all faith backgrounds to work together with those who uphold our laws to help community members and law enforcement connect on a personal level and in doing so, create safer and stronger neighborhoods. The weekend chosen this year is also our yearly parish celebration of our patron saint's Feast Day – October 8-9. We will be cooperating with other faith communities and the police of Manasquan and Sea Girt to take part in this inaugural event. After a planning meeting this week, please be on the lookout for announcements to help prepare for the event and also to set aside the time to attend.

Another major item that was discussed at the meeting was the national roll-out of the new "988" number. This new 3-digit code is for anyone having thoughts of suicide and experiencing a mental health or substance use crisis. The existing National Suicide Prevention Lifeline (1-800-273-8255) is still in use, but the transition to the use of 988 has begun. When calling 988, callers first hear a greeting while the call is routed to the local Lifeline crisis center based on the area code of the caller.
