A Message from Father Bill

Happy Advent! God Bless you as we begin this New Liturgical Year! It is in the experiencing of the cycle of the Liturgical Year that we grow in the grace God gives to those who serve God and the mysteries of God in our religious calendar year. The Liturgical Calendar of the Church reminds us that we are “in the world, but not of the world”. The Liturgical Calendar reminds us that our time is God’s time. Our time is not meant to be lived solely in the “*chronos*” of the world (“*chronos*” is the Greek word for “time” meaning the chronological aspect of time – minutes, days, months, etc). To live in chronological time is to put the importance on a “to do list” kind of existence that just wears us out. Our time is God’s time in the sense of “*Kairos*” time (“*Kairos*” is the Greek word for “time” meaning “**the appointed time in the purpose of God,**” the time when God acts and it is also “a time when conditions are right for the accomplishment of a crucial action : the opportune and decisive moment”, the time when we act.

Our Liturgical Calendar is filled with “*Kairos*” – seasons of opportunity for us to reflect on the aspects of Salvation History, when the time was right for God to act, and in those seasons there are opportunities for us to act for God’s purpose in our lives. This new Liturgical Year, may God give us the grace to see God’s “*Kairos*” and be open to how we are called to enter into that time. Let us see our seasons of the Church year as times when conditions are right for us to act decisively to progress in our spiritual life, which is nothing less than a journey closer to God and the Communion of Heaven. This is such a better way to go through life than only the temporary passing things of a solely “*chronos*”-way of passing time.

We begin our Year of Grace with the “*chronos*” of Advent. The time is right to recall God preparing the world for the arrival of Jesus, our Messiah. The time is right for us to seize the opportunities to spend time in prayer and reflection and action based on love of God and neighbor in the joy of the anticipation of celebrating Christmas. May God bless you in this New Year of Grace. May each of us see Advent and all the seasons of the Liturgical Year as important opportunities to enter more deeply into the mystery of God’s love for us. 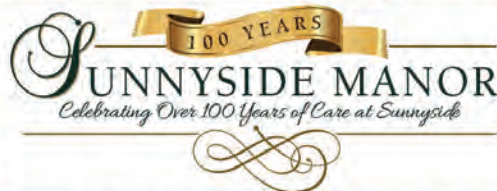
