
Twenty-eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time October 15, 2023







A MESSAGE FROM FATHER BILL

Much to share about the St. Denis Parish Outreach Program for the rest of this year. I am pragmatic, as you know, so some of this (see the chart below) will be about our calendar for planning purposes. But first and foremost is the spiritual reality of our lives as Catholics, that I wish to encourage as your pastor. This parish is truly magnanimous in responding to Jesus' call -"Love your neighbor as you love yourself" "whatsoever you do to the least of my sisters and brothers, that you do to me". I am thankful for the generosity we show to our neighbors in need - neighbors near and far. We are called to put our faith, hope and love into concrete action. As St. Teresa of Avilla wrote: Christ has no body but yours, no hands, no feet on earth but yours, yours are the eyes with which he looks with compassion on this world, yours are the feet with which he walks to do good, yours are the hands, with which he blesses all the world. This week we celebrate "Catholic Daughters of the Americas" Sunday – one of the many groups of our parish who respond with faith, hope and love to people in need and are currently helping children through the Tutwiler Clinic Toy Drive.

Please continue to pray for the people we are hoping to help and be the hands and feet and eyes of Christ as we answer the call of Christ to love our neighbor.
