A MESSAGE FROM FATHER BILL

Our focus for Lent is "progress". God gives us the Sacrament of Confession to help us progress in the spiritual life. This sacrament is also called the Sacrament of Reconciliation, Penance, Forgiveness and *Conversion*. *Conversion* is a process of changing through the acknowledgement of the truth of our life, both the times we follow God's grace and the times we do not, and then acting in a hopeful manner to progress. Hope is, as one spiritual author wrote, a way to disavow the negative because of the presence of the positive - God with us. The Sacrament (which means 'oath') of Conversion lets us make progress in our relationship with God and others by a truthful acknowledgement of the negative, sinful aspects of our life and an oath to make a firm purpose of amendment by taking the steps to make progress forward - always with Hope (an understanding of God's call to a relationship with purpose and meaning in relationships with God, self, and others).

We will have "drop-in" confessions on Monday, in the church, from 11:00am-1:00pm and again from 6:00-8:00 pm. All are invited to take the opportunity to celebrate the sacrament. We will have a few priests available at each session. Also, if needed please make an appointment with Fr. Bill for confession before Palm Sunday, so that you can take seriously the invitation to "repent and believe in the Gospel", as we heard on Ash Wednesday, and continue to progress in your Lenten journey to the celebration of Easter and the time to renew our Baptismal call to follow Christ as His disciples.

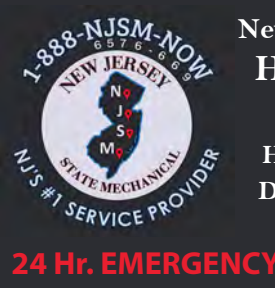

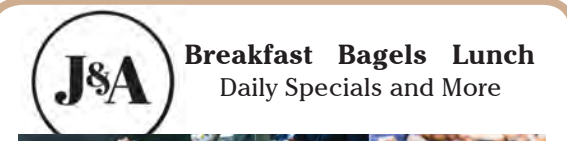

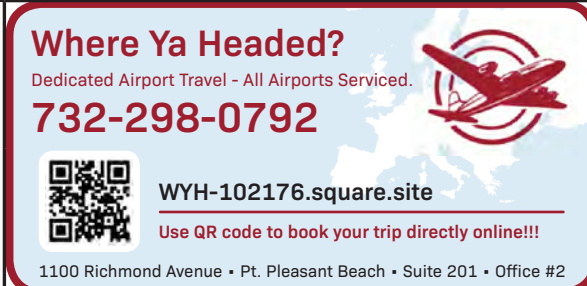
