“The community of believers was of one heart and mind, and no one claimed that any of his possessions was his own, but they held everything in common. With great power the apostles bore witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and great favor was accorded them all. There was no needy person among them.”

As we live the joy of the Easter season, let's pause and take a test. I ask myself if our Parish can identify with the description of Saint Luke of the first followers of Jesus. Do I recognize that everything I have is a gift God has given me? He wants me to use it for the benefit of someone else. Maybe I am the person in need, and I will discover how I can contribute it to our parish community, or small group with whom I share? Whatever gift or talent I possess is not for me, but to be brought and used for the benefit of someone else. The corporal works of mercy are the perfect way to begin: an invitation to someone to return to the sacraments, a donation for the food pantry or a gift card to the supermarket, a get well card or phone call to a homebound person, a prayer intention - how important yet easy. As I do my part, the community of the Acts of the Apostles becomes mine - food pantry or gift card. My need is to do something. This is divine mercy in action.

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER BILL

Happy Divine Mercy Sunday. We celebrated Easter is such an awesome way as a parish family. What great prayer, liturgies, what great piety and reverence in all we experienced. What a joyful reception of people into full communion in the Catholic Church and a joyful reception of the sacraments of initiation by all who took part (more than any other year I have been here). What a great show of support and show of generosity in the collections for Easter and Easter flowers. Thank you to you all. Thank you to the Deacons. Thank you to Mark and Casey and all in the music ministry. Thanks to all of the lay ministers and ushers who helped with liturgies.

We continue in our Easter Season today celebrating God's Mercy. Our progress for Easter is to recognize how we are called to live in the light of the Gospel and fight despair in our lives, letting the mercy of the Father, Risen Lord, and Holy Spirit conquer any fear, indecision, and doubt we may have. We are called to receive God's mercy and let the joy of Jesus, who conquered them in His life, do the same through, with and in us. The starting point for our progressing in Easter is Jesus' words "**Peace be with you**" and "**Do not be afraid**" and His action of Divine Mercy.

With this in mind, I ask you to take part in the Parish Mission that will begin on Divine Mercy Sunday and continue on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday evenings in the church. It will be a great way to reflect on and experience God's mercy and respond to the invitation to grow more joyful, to be less fearful and anxious, and to progress in sharing life and communion with the Risen Lord, and experience its fruits in your life.
