Repent, therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be wiped away.’”

The Acts of the Apostles, the story of the first Christians and early church has wonderful sermons, or teachings from St. Peter and Saint Paul. As people ask where I should begin to read the Bible, it is suggested that we look to those sermons to set the stage for our understanding.

I am thankful for all your Easter participation; the Holy Days were celebrated by the largest groups since the pandemic! I want to thank you for your presence, prayers and support.

We have a bunch of people who “adopt a spot” – pick an area of our parish and step up to take care of that area. 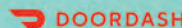
