“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth. While they were looking intently at the sky as he was going, suddenly two men dressed in white garments stood beside them. They said, ‘Men of Galilee why are you standing looking at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven.’”

The earthly ministry of Jesus draws to a close, but the mission of the apostles, and the church of today begins. We are not just to ‘stand there’ looking at the sky, but are to look for the many ways the Lord is asking and then sending us to continue His saving work in a weary and disordered world.

If the chosen apostles had just stayed there, we would not be reading this today. He expects great things of all the baptized, and as Saint John Newman said ‘the Lord has given ME a mission, and as long as I fail to do my part, it will always remain undone.’ Don’t just stand there!

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER BILL

We celebrate the Feast of the Ascension of the Lord, which has been transferred from Thursday to Sunday. It was celebrated on a Thursday as a remembrance of the actual timing of Jesus' Ascension to heaven. After appearing to the early Church for 40 days beginning with Easter Sunday, during which time He was forming them to continue His mission on earth, Jesus told the disciples to pray for the Holy Spirit to come. Nine days later, the first novena, the Pentecost event occurred. We know, from the Bible, that Jesus appeared not only to the Blessed Mother and the Apostles on Easter, but He also appeared to them and also to St. Paul as well as many others during the 40 days. In His Ascension, Jesus takes the human nature He assumed at the Incarnation, to Heaven, so that where He went, we may also follow! As the Collect says: *Gladden us with holy joys, almighty God, and make us rejoice with devout thanksgiving, for the Ascension of Christ your Son is our exaltation, and, where the Head has gone before in glory, the Body is called to follow in hope.*

We celebrate all mothers today, Happy Mother's Day!!! We are thankful for all women of Faith, Hope and Love who give life and share life with their children and the community of St. Denis. May God bless you in your vocation. We also ask God to bless those women who live the virtue of motherhood to those around them who are not their children. That virtue of motherhood – compassionate and nurturing caring – is needed in society and is not taken for granted! Thank you and God bless you.

We also commemorate National Police Week May 12-18, 2024. In 1962, President John F. Kennedy proclaimed May 15th as National Peace Officers Memorial Day and the calendar week in which May 15th falls, National Police Week. National Police Week pays special recognition to law enforcement officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty for the safety and protection of others. Beginning April 8, the names of 282 officers who died in the line of duty will be engraved on the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial. Of those officers, 118 died in 2023 the other 164 officers died in years prior to 2023. These law enforcement officers will be honored during the 36th Annual Candlelight Vigil held on the National Mall at 8 p.m. on May 13, 2024. Two of our parishioners, Sgt. Ryan Quigley and Det. Sgt. John Ringo, are the first police officers in Police Dept. of Manasquan taking part in the Police Unity Tour which raises funds for the national memorial as well as draws attention to the sacrifice made by those who have died. These officers left from Hamilton, NJ on the 9th and will arrive in Washington D.C. on the 12th. We pray for the Sgts. Ringo and Quigley and the success of the mission of the Unity Tour. I also draw your attention to the blessing of the Police Memorial on Thursday the 16th at 6 pm at Abe Vorhees Plaza and also the First Responders Mass we will host on Wednesday the 29th at 7 pm at the church. Please make every effort to attend and join in the prayer.
