HIS WORD TODAY



A THANK YOU NOTE FROM THE HENRY B. KING MEDICAL BRIGADE-

Dear Esteemed Patrons and Generous Donors,

As we reflect on another year of service with the Henry B. King Medical Brigade in Honduras, we are filled with gratitude for your unwavering support and dedication to our cause. Your generosity has been the cornerstone of our ability to make a meaningful difference in the lives of the Honduran people. This year, we were able to provide much-needed medical assistance to approximately 26 underprivileged villages of Honduras.

We are thrilled to share that, with your help, we were able to treat over 2,000 patients. Our interdisciplinary team includes Pharmacists, Physicians, Physician Assistants, Nurses, Physical Therapists, Translators and Helpers. Some interesting cases that were seen and treated included; malignant inner thigh mass removal, some tropical viruses including chikungunya and zika virus, secondary syphilis, excision of a pregnancy tumor, lipoma excision, Charcot foot and many chronic wounds and animal bites, metal foreign body eye extraction, open inguinal and umbilical hernia repair, and diabetic foot ulcer debridement. We also managed severe diabetic patients with hyperglycemia requiring immediate insulin administration and intravenous hydration. Nutritional education was also provided. We also made a house call to help an 85year-old man with a history of ankle fracture repaired years prior by insertion of a single metal screw.

None of this would have been possible without your support. We would like to express our deepest gratitude for your generous donations, which helped us to purchase essential medical supplies and medications.

As we look ahead to the future, we are committed to building upon the successes of the past year and expanding our reach to serve even more individuals in need.


