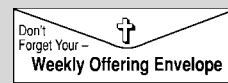
A MESSAGE FROM FATHER BILL

As we prepare to celebrate the Feast of the Annunciation (on the 25th), we pray for all those who are praying as they expect the birth of their child, and praying in the hope of conceiving a child, adopting a child, or fostering a child. As we remember the Incarnation of our Lord in the womb of the Blessed Virgin, nine months before His birth, we recognize the special gift of life made even more special by the fact that "The Word became flesh, and made His dwelling among us." (John 1,14). With this in mind, we will have a special blessing at the 9:30 am Mass next weekend. Please spread the word and invite all those who would benefit from this blessing. As we read in Vatican II: God has carefully, tenderly created every person in His own image and likeness, to be in a loving relationship with Himself. From each tiny child knit within a mother’s womb, to every person approaching death, all are loved perfectly and completely by God: “It is therefore a service of love which we are all committed to ensure to our neighbor, that his or her life may be always defended and promoted, *especially when it is weak or threatened*” (*Evangelium vitae* 77).

Tremendous thanks to all who have donated to the Annual Catholic Appeal!!! We have achieved our goal!, and in record time!!! We not only have 106% pledged, we also have well over 5% increase in donors (nearly 20%). And we are 96% pledges paid. 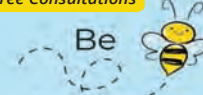

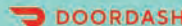
